**VERIFIED PETITION FOR WRIT OF
MANDATE**

**Elections Matter: Entitled to Priority
Per Elections Code, § 13314**

1 COMES NOW Petitioner CYNTHIA WARD and alleges as follows:

2 **INTRODUCTION**

3 1. This action is brought pursuant to Elections Code sections 13103, 13104,
4 13107, 13307, 13313, and 13314 to correct a false, misleading, and unlawful statement of
5 a candidate's name and to correct a false, misleading, and unlawful ballot designation.

6 2. Real Party in Interest Steven Lodge ("Lodge") is a candidate for the
7 Anaheim City Council in the November 6, 2012, election. Elections Code section 13103
8 requires inclusion of the names of qualified candidates. Lodge has requested that his
9 name appear on the ballot as "Steve Chavez Lodge." On information and belief, this is
10 not his legal name. Nor is that the name under which he is registered to vote or the name
11 under which he owns property. Rather, the use of the middle name "Chavez" appears to
12 have been adopted recently for political purposes.

13 3. Lodge's selected name to appear on the ballot violates the Elections Code
14 and should be struck from the ballot materials.

15 4. Pursuant to California Elections Code section 13107, Lodge is entitled to
16 choose a ballot designation to appear immediately under his name on the ballot. The
17 Elections Code provides that a candidate like Lodge may choose a ballot designation of
18 no more than three words describing his current principal professions, vocations, or
19 occupations.

20 5. Lodge's chosen designation as "Retired Policeman/Businessman" violates
21 the Elections Code. Lodge does not meet the requirements set forth in Elections Code
22 section 13107, subdivision (b), and in Title 2 of the California Code of Regulations,
23 section 20716, subdivision (h), to designate himself as a "Retired Policeman." That
24 designation must be struck from the ballot materials.

25 6. Petitioner Cynthia Ward, an elector of the city of Anaheim, therefore seeks
26 by this action to compel Respondent Neal Kelley, the Orange County Registrar of Voters,
27 and Respondent Linda Andal, the clerk of the city of Anaheim, to require use of Lodge's
28 legal name and to reject candidate Lodge's false and misleading ballot designation.

1 **PARTIES**

2 7. Petitioner CYNTHIA WARD is a resident, taxpayer, and qualified,
3 registered elector of the city of Anaheim.

4 8. Respondent NEAL KELLEY is the Orange County Registrar and is sued
5 herein in his official capacity. Among Respondent Kelley's duties and responsibilities as
6 the Orange County Registrar are the duties to issue, accept, and certify candidates
7 nomination documents for the November 6, 2012, Anaheim City Council election, and to
8 ensure the accuracy and lawfulness of the ballot designations chosen by those candidates,
9 and to reject any ballot information or designations that violate the restrictions contained
10 in Elections Code sections 13103, 13104, 13107, and 13307. Respondent Kelley's duties
11 also include preparing and printing the ballots, sample ballots, and other official matters
12 in connection with that election.

13 9. Respondent LINDA ANDAL is the City Clerk of the City of Anaheim and is
14 sued herein in her official capacity. Among Respondent Andal's duties and
15 responsibilities are the duties to issue and accept candidates' nomination documents for
16 the November 6, 2012, Anaheim City Council election. Respondent Andal, in her official
17 capacity, has "charge of all City elections." (Charter of the City of Anaheim, section 704,
18 subdivision (h).)

19 10. Petitioner is unaware of the true names and capacities of Respondents
20 DOES 1 through 10, inclusive. Petitioner is informed and believes, and thereupon
21 alleges, that each of Respondents Does 1 through 10 is responsible in some manner for
22 the events and happenings referred to in this Petition and is therefore liable for the acts
23 and activities alleged herein. Petitioner will seek leave of Court to amend this Petition to
24 set forth the true names and capacities of these respondents when the same have been
25 ascertained.

26 11. Real Party in Interest STEVEN LODGE is a candidate for Member of the
27 Anaheim City Council at the November 6, 2012, election. Lodge is the candidate who
28 chose the candidate name and ballot designation that are challenged in this action.

1 property at 8616 Canyon Vista Dr., Anaheim, CA 92808, and that Lodge owns the
2 property under the name "Steven A Lodge." (See Exhibit B.) This is the same address at
3 which Lodge is registered to vote. (A true and correct copy of a screen print out of
4 Lodge's voter registration record is attached to this Verified Petition as Exhibit C.)

5 18. The background report also identifies "Tonya L Compton" as a co-owner of
6 the 8616 Canyon Vista Dr. property. (See Exhibit B.) On Lodge's campaign website
7 (www.stevelodgeforanaheim.com), he refers to his wife "Tonya," in the "About Steve"
8 section. (A true and correct copy of a screen print out of the "About Steve" section of
9 Lodge's website is attached to this Verified Petition as Exhibit D.)

10 19. Lodge is also registered to vote as "Steven Lodge," with no mention of the
11 name "Chavez." (See Exhibit C.) The Elections Code requires a voter to register to vote
12 using the "affiant's name at length, including his or her given name, and a middle name
13 or initial, or if the initial of the given name is customarily used, then the initial and middle
14 name." (Elec. Code, § 2150, subd. (a)(2).) Registration to vote in the district in which a
15 candidate seeks election is a requirement for candidacy. (See Gov. Code, § 36502
16 subd. (a).) By registering to vote as "Steven Lodge," Lodge confirmed that his true and
17 complete name is "Steven Lodge."

18 20. Lodge has previously identified himself on official documents filed in
19 connection with his candidacy for Anaheim City Council as "Steve Lodge." Lodge's
20 Form 501 Candidate Intention Statement was submitted to Respondent Andal in
21 October 2011 under the name as "Steve Lodge." Lodge signed that document as "Steve
22 Lodge." (A true and correct copy of Lodge's Candidate Intention Statement is attached
23 hereto as Exhibit E.)

24 21. In October 2011, Lodge also submitted to Respondent Andal a Form 410,
25 Statement of Organization, for the "Lodge for City Council 2012" committee. That
26 document asks candidates to list the "name of officeholder or candidate." Lodge filled in
27 "Steve Lodge" and signed his name as "Steve Lodge." (A true and correct copy of the
28 campaign's Statement of Organization is attached hereto as Exhibit F.)

1 22. Lodge has previously made political contributions under the name "Steven
2 Lodge." For instance, in 2002, Lodge made three separate contributions to the Santa Ana
3 Police Officers Political Action Committee totaling \$50.00 under the name "Steven
4 Lodge." (A true and correct copy of a "Contributor Report" for Steven Lodge from the
5 California Secretary of State's website, accessed on August 17, 2012, is attached to this
6 Verified Petition as Exhibit G.)

7 23. In 2006 and 2007, Lodge made four contributions totaling \$173.16 to the
8 Santa Ana Police Officers Association Independent Expenditure Committee under the
9 name "Steven Lodge." (A true and correct copy of a "Contributor Report" for Steven
10 Lodge from the California Secretary of State's website, accessed on August 17, 2012, is
11 attached to this Verified Petition as Exhibit H.)

12 24. On May 19, 2010, Lodge donated money to the Committee to Re-Elect
13 Loretta Sanchez under the name "Steven Lodge." (A true and copy of a Contribution
14 Report for Steven Lodge from the Federal Election Commission's website, accessed on
15 August 17, 2012, is attached to this Verified Petition as Exhibit I.)

16 25. Accordingly, Lodge's proposed use of the name "Steve Chavez Lodge" on
17 the ballot is false and misleading. His name must be amended to appear before the voters
18 as "Steven Lodge," the name under which he registered to vote and filed his Candidate
19 Intention Statement.

20 **B. Lodge's Illegal Ballot Designation**

21 26. Pursuant to Elections Code section 13107, candidates for elective office may
22 choose one of four possible types of ballot designations. (Elec. Code, § 13107, subd. (a).)
23 Section 13107, subdivision (a) provides in pertinent part:

24 “(a) With the exception of candidates for Justice of the State
25 Supreme Court or Court of Appeal, immediately under the name of
26 each candidate, and not separated from the name by any line, unless
27 the designation made by the candidate pursuant to Section 8002.5
28 must be listed immediately below the name of the candidate pursuant
to Section 13105, and in that case immediately under the
designation, may appear at the option of the candidate only one of
the following designations:

1 “(1) Words designating the elective city, county, district, state,
2 or federal office which the candidate holds at the time of filing the
3 nomination documents to which he or she was elected by vote of the
4 people, or to which he or she was appointed, in the case of a superior
5 court judge.

6 “(2) The word “incumbent” if the candidate is a candidate for
7 the same office which he or she holds at the time of filing the
8 nomination papers, and was elected to that office by a vote of the
9 people, or, in the case of a superior court judge, was appointed to
10 that office.

11 “(3) No more than three words designating either the *current*
12 *principal professions, vocations, or occupations of the candidate*, or
13 the principal professions, vocations, or occupations of the candidate
14 during the calendar year immediately preceding the filing of
15 nomination documents. For purposes of this section, all California
16 geographical names shall be considered to be one word. Hyphenated
17 words that appear in any generally available standard reference
18 dictionary, published in the United States at any time within the 10
19 calendar years immediately preceding the election for which the
20 words are counted, shall be considered as one word. Each part of all
21 other hyphenated words shall be counted as a separate word.

22 “(4) The phrase “appointed incumbent” if the candidate holds
23 an office other than a judicial office by virtue of appointment, and
24 the candidate is a candidate for election to the same office, or, if the
25 candidate is a candidate for election to the same office or to some
26 other office, the word “appointed” and the title of the office. . . .”
27 (Elec. Code, § 13107, subd. (a) (emphasis added).)

28 27. Because Lodge currently holds no elective office and is not an incumbent or
appointed incumbent for the office he is seeking, his only option is to proceed under
Elections Code section 13107, subdivision (a)(3), and to provide no more than three
words designating his “current principal professions, vocations, or occupations.”

28 28. Underscoring the requirement that a ballot designation be the candidate’s
“current” principal professions, vocations, or occupations, the Elections Code prohibits
ballot designations that use words or prefixes, such as “former” or “ex-,” which indicate
prior status. (Elec. Code., § 13107, subd. (b)(4).)

28 29. Only in limited circumstances may a candidate use the word “retired” in a
ballot designation. For instance, a “candidate may not use the word ‘retired’ in his or her
ballot designation if that candidate possesses a more recent, intervening principal
profession, vocation, or occupation.” (Cal. Code Regs., § 20716, subd. (h)(4).)

1 30. In contravention of these clear restrictions, Lodge has selected as his ballot
2 designation “Retired Policeman/Businessman.” (See Exhibit A.)

3 31. In doing so, Lodge is at once claiming that he is a “Retired Policeman” who
4 does not “possess a more recent, intervening principal profession, vocation, or
5 occupation” (Cal Code Regs., § 20716, subd. (h)(4)) *and* that his “current principal
6 profession, vocation, or occupation” (Elec. Code § 13107, subd. (a)(3)) is a
7 “Businessman.”

8 32. Lodge cannot legally use the ballot designation “Retired Policeman”
9 because, by his own admission, after retiring as a police officer, he acquired “another
10 more recent, intervening principal profession, vocation, or occupation” (Cal Code Regs.,
11 § 20716, subd. (h)(4)) — that of a “Businessman.”

12 33. In addition to his ballot designation claiming to be a “Businessman,” his
13 candidate statement asserts that “[s]ince retiring from the police force I have worked for a
14 large construction management firm.” (See Exhibit A.)

15 34. Lodge’s campaign website also boasts that “[a]fter 30 years of public
16 service, I joined an international construction management firm as Director of Public
17 Affairs.” (See Exhibit D.)

18 35. Earlier this month, in August 2012, Lodge filed with the Fair Political
19 Practices Commission a Form 700 Statement of Economic Interests in which he reported
20 income for calendar year 2011 between \$10,000 and \$100,000 from Hill International,
21 Inc., a construction management firm. Lodge further disclosed in that submission that he
22 holds the position of Director of Public Affairs at that company. (A true and correct copy
23 of Lodge’s Form 700 is attached to this Verified Petition as Exhibit J.)

24 36. Inclusion of “Retired Policeman” in Lodge’s ballot designation is therefore
25 unlawful and must be struck from the ballot.

26 37. In addition to the prohibition of the use of the word “retired” when, as is the
27 case here, a “candidate possesses a more recent, intervening principal profession,
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1 vocation, or occupation” (Cal. Code Regs., § 20716, subd. (h)(4)), the Registrar must
2 consider various factors in determining whether a proposed ballot designation containing
3 the word “retired” is accurate and permissible:

4 “(2) In evaluating a proposed ballot designation including the
5 word “retired,” the Secretary of State will consider the following
6 factors in making a determination as to the propriety of the use of the
7 term “Retired”:

8 “(A) Prior to retiring from his or her principal profession,
9 vocation or occupation, the candidate worked in such profession,
10 vocation or occupation for more than 5 years;

11 “(B) The candidate is collecting, or eligible to collect,
12 retirement benefits or other type of vested pension;

13 “(C) The candidate has reached at least the age of 55 years;

14 “(D) The candidate voluntarily left his or her last professional,
15 vocational, or occupational position; and

16 “(E) The candidate’s retirement benefits are providing him or
17 her with a principal source of income.” (2 Cal. Code Regs., § 20716,
18 subd. (h)(2).

19 38. Petitioner is informed and believes, and on that basis alleges, that Lodge has
20 not reached 55 years of age.

21 39. Petitioner is further informed and believes, and on that basis alleges, that
22 Lodge’s retirement benefits are not his principal source of income. As reflected in
23 Lodge’s Form 700 disclosure, for calendar year 2011, he received from \$10,000 to
24 \$100,000 in income from Hill International, Inc., for his work as a Director of Public
25 Affairs. (See Exhibit J.)

26 40. As Lodge does not meet at least two of the criteria under this test, he cannot
27 legally use the word “retired” on his ballot designation.

28 41. Lodge has the burden of establishing that the proposed ballot designation
that he has submitted is accurate and complies with all provisions of Elections Code
section 13107. (2 Cal. Code Regs., § 20717, subd. (c).)

42. Respondent Orange County Registrar Kelley has the duty to reject any ballot
designation that would mislead voters or otherwise violate section 13107. (Elec. Code,

1 § 13107, subs. (b)(1) & (c); see also 2 Cal. Code Regs., § 20716, subd. (a.)

2 43. Petitioner is informed and believes, and on that basis alleges, that Lodge did
3 not meet his burden of establishing the accuracy and lawfulness of his proposed ballot
4 designation.

5 44. Petitioner has no plain, speedy and adequate remedy in the ordinary course
6 of law, in that no damages or other legal remedy could compensate for the harm that she
7 and the other electors of Anaheim would suffer if Lodge's inaccurate, misleading and
8 unlawful proposed name and ballot designation were to appear on the ballot materials.
9 Petitioner, who is a resident, taxpayer, and qualified elector of the City of Anaheim, has a
10 direct and beneficial interest in the action herein and brings this action as a private
11 attorney general pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 1021.5 to vindicate her own
12 interests and those of the electors of Anaheim in the proper implementation of the
13 provisions of the California Elections Code.

14 **FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION**

15 Code of Civil Procedure § 1085; Elections Code §§ 13103 and 13314

16 (Writ of Mandate)

17 45. Petitioner realleges and hereby incorporates by reference each and every
18 allegation contained in paragraphs 1 through 44, above.

19 46. Respondents Orange County Registrar Neal Kelley and Anaheim City Clerk
20 Linda Andal have a clear, present, and ministerial duty to reject Real Party in Interest
21 Lodge's unsupported, inaccurate, misleading, and illegal proposed name of "Steve
22 Chavez Lodge" and not to print that name on the ballots, sample ballots, and other official
23 matter for the November 6, 2012, election.

24 47. If not otherwise directed by the Court's issuance of the requested writ of
25 mandate, Respondents Orange County Registrar Neal Kelley and Anaheim City Clerk
26 Linda Andal will accept Real Party in Interest Lodge's unsupported, inaccurate,
27 misleading, and illegal proposed name of "Steve Chavez Lodge" and will print it on the
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1 ballots, sample ballots, and other official matter for the November 6, 2012, election,
2 thereby depriving Petitioner and the electors of the City of Anaheim of their right to an
3 accurate ballot and a fair election. The issuance of the requested writ of mandate will not
4 substantially interfere with the conduct of the election.

5 **SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION**

6 Code Civ. Proc., § 1085; Elec. Code, §§ 13107, 13314

7 (Writ of Mandate)

8 48. Petitioner realleges and hereby incorporates by reference each and every
9 allegation contained in paragraphs 1 through 47, above.

10 49. Respondents Orange County Registrar Neal Kelley and Anaheim City Clerk
11 Linda Andal have a clear, present, and ministerial duty to reject Real Party in Interest
12 Lodge's unsupported, inaccurate, misleading and illegal proposed ballot designation as
13 "Retired Policeman/Businessman" and not to print that designation on the ballots, sample
14 ballots, and other official matter for the November 6, 2012, election.

15 50. If not otherwise directed by the Court's issuance of the requested writ of
16 mandate, Respondents Orange County Registrar Neal Kelley and Anaheim City Clerk
17 Linda Andal will accept Real Party in Interest Lodge's unsupported, inaccurate,
18 misleading, and illegal proposed ballot designation of "Retired Policeman/Businessman"
19 and will print it on the ballots, sample ballots, and other official matter for the November
20 6, 2012, election, thereby depriving Petitioner and the electors of the City of Anaheim of
21 their right to an accurate ballot and a fair election. The issuance of the requested writ of
22 mandate will not substantially interfere with the conduct of the election.

23 **PRAYER FOR RELIEF**

24 WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays for judgment as follows:

25 1. On the First Cause of Action, that this Court issues its alternative and
26 peremptory writs of mandate commanding Respondents Kelley and Andal to reject Real
27 Party in Interest Lodge's proposed candidate name of "Steve Chavez Lodge," to amend
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1 the candidate name to comply with the Elections Code, and to refrain from printing or
2 otherwise including Real Party in Interest Lodge's proposed name of "Steve Chavez
3 Lodge" on the ballots, sample ballots, and other official matter for the November 6, 2012
4 election unless and until it is amended to comply with the law. Permissible versions of
5 Lodge's name include "Steven Lodge" or "Steve Lodge."

6 2. On the Second Cause of Action, that this Court issue its alternative and
7 peremptory writs of mandate commanding Respondents Kelley and Andal to reject Real
8 Party in Interest Lodge's proposed ballot designation of "Retired
9 Policeman/Businessman" and to refrain from printing or otherwise including Real Party
10 in Interest Lodge's proposed ballot designation of "Retired Policeman/Businessman" on
11 the ballots, sample ballots, and other official matter for the November 6, 2012 election
12 unless and until it is amended to comply with the law.

13 3. That this Court grant Petitioner her costs, including out-of-pocket expenses,
14 and reasonable attorneys' fees; and

15 4. That this Court grant such other, further or different relief as the Court may
16 deem just and proper.



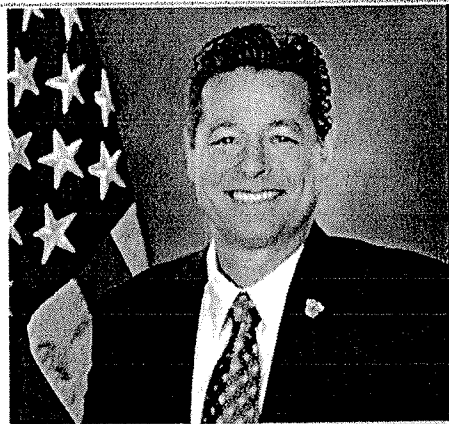

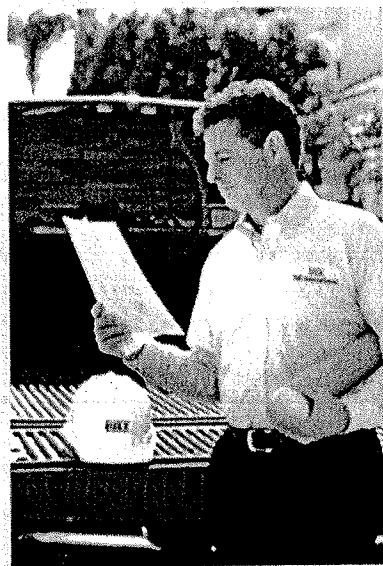
